From the Director -Dear Friends.

During the pandemic FVPC was able to continue providing trauma informed services to victims and survivors. Services have been conducted through remote confidential platforms. Throughout the past year we have evaluated the volume of services provided and determined that more space for services is a necessity. An evaluation of the environmental components of a trauma informed care agency was conducted and indicated that there is little space appropriately dedicated to trauma informed outreach services. Survivors must be treated with respect in an environment that provides hope, stating that recovery is possible. The value of FVPC's trauma recovery services can be heard and felt in a survivor's message about gaining help, "I waited, don't wait. If you love yourself, get the help!" FVPC needs to be ready to welcome each and every victim to start an individual healing path.



We are planning to build an Outreach Center to better serve survivors of domestic and sexual violence in Greene County. FVPC began to officially serve sexual violence survivors in 2011. Another step was taken during the spring of 2019 when FVPC completed the process through the Ohio Alliance to End Sexual Violence and the Ohio Attorney General's Office to serve as the Certified Rape Crisis Center for Greene County, officially starting in July 2019. Both domestic and sexual violence victims and survivors are served in our space. Due to the volume of survivors' requests for existing services we are limited in the existing confidential space where these services can be provided. Additional physical space is required to increase the advocacy, counseling, education, and support services that help empower our clients. These services require privacy and security that are currently problematic, based on the number of survivors requiring them and the diversity of their needs. As we look to a time in the near future when services will return to the facility, as Covid restrictions are reduced, we know we must have a solution for more space.

#### Our Goal and How We Plan to Get There

We want to build a dedicated Outreach Center within the next year to contain all the resources needed to support the advocacy, counseling, education and support services including: Healthy Homes (Phases I and II), Smiles, Individual Counseling, Voices, Women Who Resort to Force, and Sexual Assault Survivor Support Group. To best serve our clients we are planning for security fencing and gates, adequate parking, landscaping, and any other features to provide a trauma-informed care environment furnishing comfort and security to survivors.

FVPC has purchased two lots on Bellbrook Ave. These lots are close to our existing facility and meet the need to erect a building with surrounding parking. Construction of the outreach center will requires fund raising in addition to the existing funds. We anticipate additional short- and long-term actions will include:

• Hiring an architect • Hiring a building contractor • Securing permitting • Ongoing fund raising • Site Preparation We are excited to bring this news to you; we will keep you informed of progress and ways for you to be involved.
